Rules and Conditions

This is our major fundraising event, if you were able to raise extra money through sponsorship it would greatly benefit our riders who are less able than you are but still enjoy their riding and contact with horses

- Hard Hats to standard BSEN 1384/PAS 015/ASTM F116395 to be worn at all times when mounted.
- Riders are reminded that in order to participate, third party insurance is compulsory and must still be valid on the date of this event.
- The organisers of the sponsored ride have taken every precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. On the part of the participants, we would request that everyone takes all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. Please obey the instructions and directions of the organisers, officials and marshals at all times.
- Riders will leave the start between 10-11am, in small groups.
- Riders doing the longer ride and slow riders should be at the start early on.
- The venue at Low Close is easy to find. From A6 south of Penrith, take B5320 over M6, fork left at Yanwath school and the venue is on the left before you reach the village of Askham. **CA10 2LG**
- There is ample parking at the venue and you will be directed into a parking space.
- Please remove all rubbish from the field when you leave.
- On the route, please leave all gates as you find them
- A large section of the ride is through private farmland in Lowther Park and is therefore not accessible at any other time.
- All routes will be clearly marked and manned wherever possible.
